

- On this site since The Doomsday Book
- Heart of the Market Place
- The Building II* listed
 - 14th Century arcades
 - Georgian Box
 - Victorian Aisles, Victorian Sanctuary
 - GREAT LOCATION ,TERRIBLE FACILITIES!
- 22 year incumbency many attempts but no real successes

THE PROJECT COSTS

- THERE'S NOWT FOR FREE prepare for a shock
 - Sit down once you've got the initial cost
 - you'll need to !!!!
- Don't change the project to chase the funding
- Define the project THEN look for funding
- Tenders

THE PROJECT FUNDING The Good and Bad

- Went Down "History Route" BAD
- Went Down "Community Route" GOOD
- On consultation evidence needed
 Employment advice , Health issues,
 Mental Health, Homeless

THE PROJECT FUNDING The Good and Bad

- So funders were found who supported
 - Employment, Health issues, Mental Health,
 The Homeless.

- Big Lottery, CRT, Biffa, WREN, Yorkshire Forward
