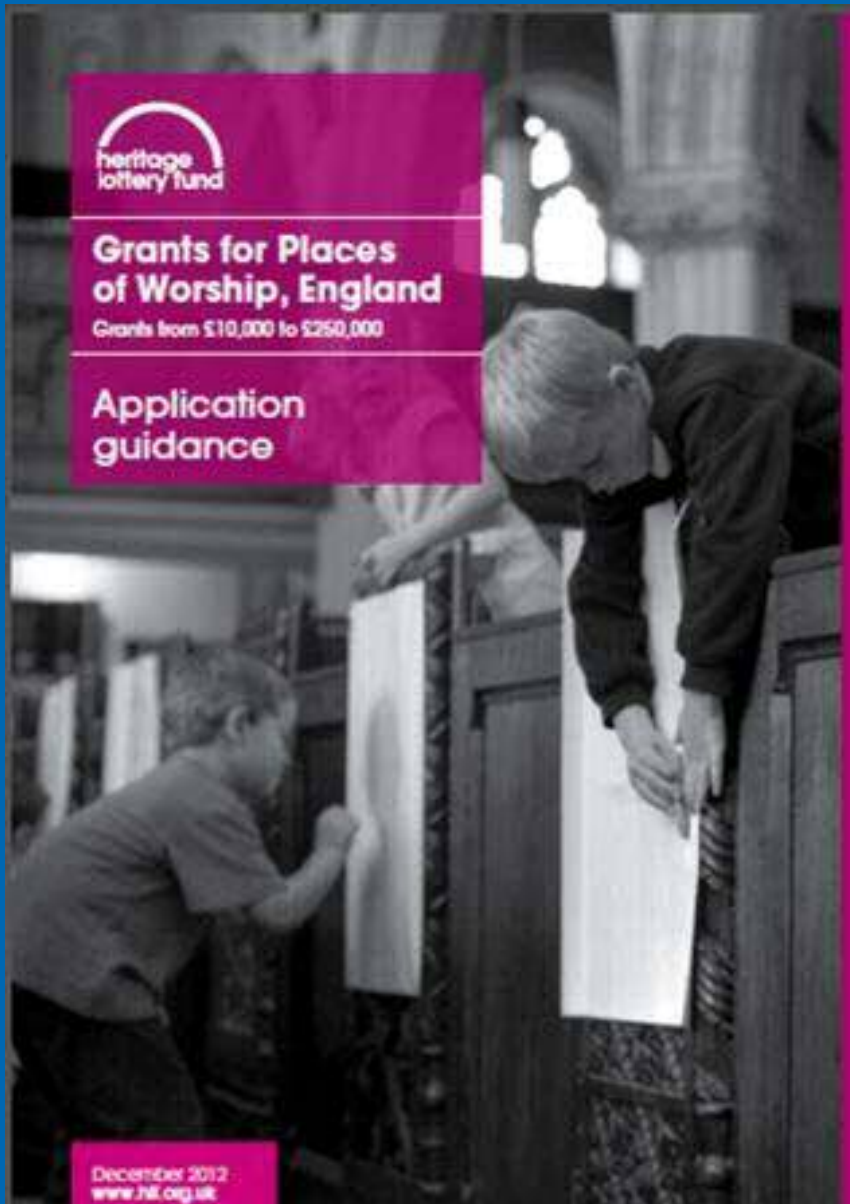
## Grants for Places of Worship

# Grants for Places of Worship



- Urgent repairs remain the priority
- £10,000 - £250,000
- Retaining a focus on the smaller, single phase projects
- Up to 15% for works to encourage sustainable use
- Encouraging wider public access

# Outcomes

- 3 sets of outcomes:
  - outcomes for Heritage
  - outcomes for individuals
  - outcomes for communities/society
- 2 minimum outcomes for GPOW:
  - Heritage in better condition (weighted)
  - More people and a wider range of people will have engaged with heritage

- Quinquennial report
- Expert advice taken from Historic England
- Activities as an opportunity not a hurdle
- Competition

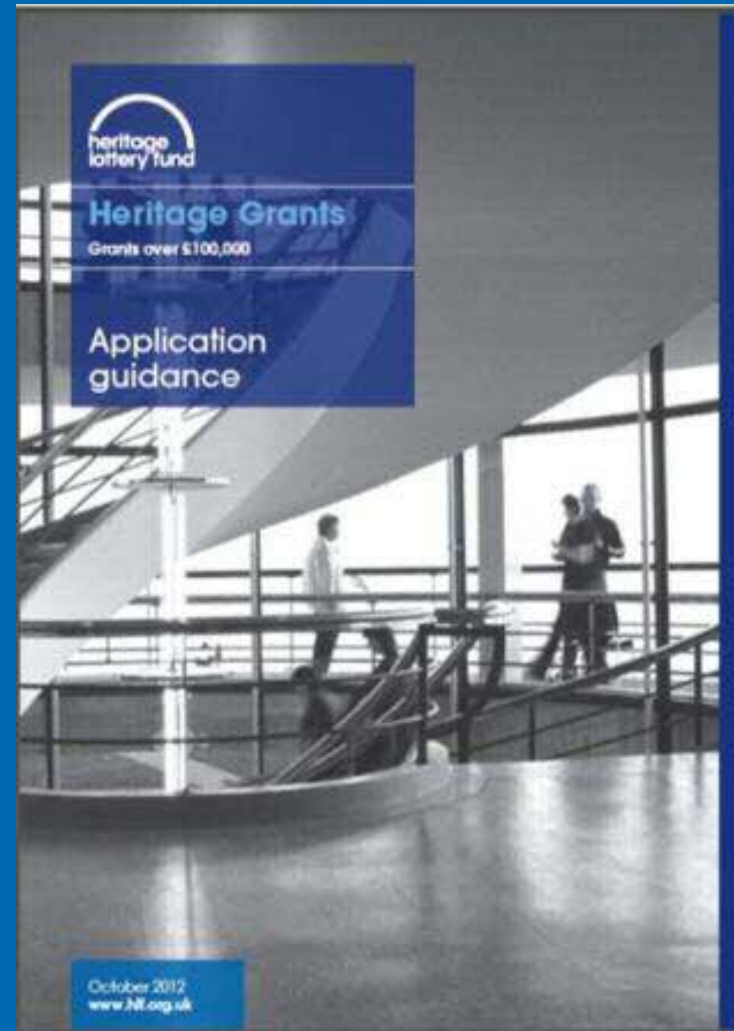
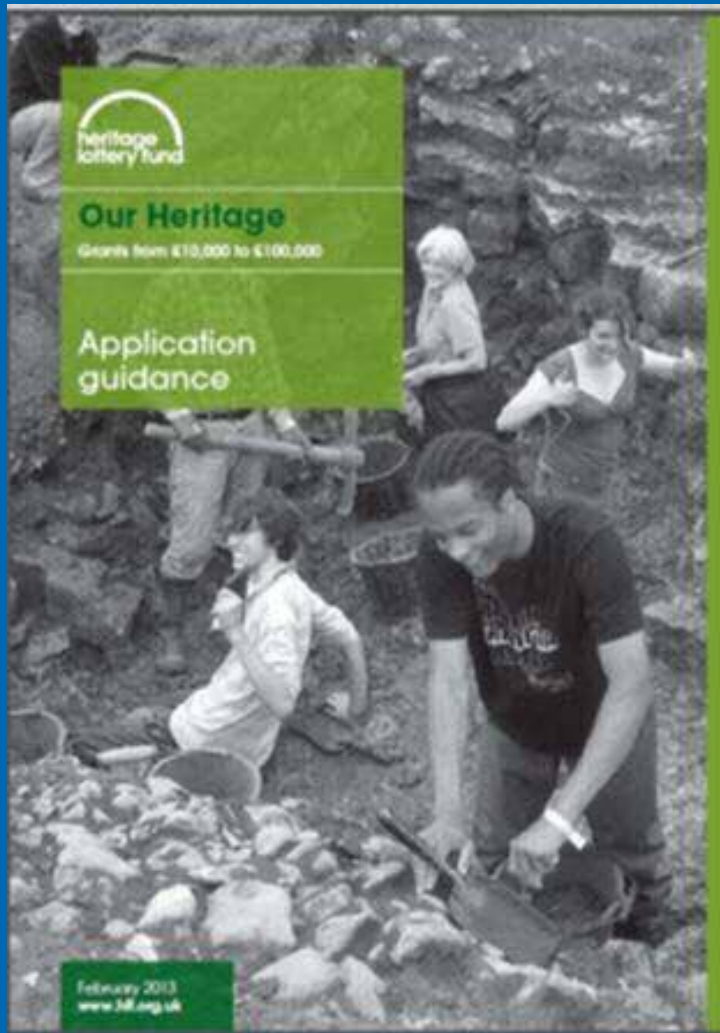
